THE PLACE- Buster Boguskie Stadium at Stratford High School (1800 Stratford Avenue, Nashville, TN 37216).

THE TIME- Saturday night, June 26, 2010. Admission gate opens at 6 PM; Kickoff at 7 PM.

THE TEAMS- The Nashville Storm (1-0, 14-1 in 2009) host the St Charles Cyclones (4-1, 3-0 in AFL League play) of the Alliance Football League. Simply put, the St Charles Cyclones have been one of America's best 10-15 adult amateur football teams for the last half-decade, playing in the MLFA, the GMFL, and now the Alliance Football League, which they joined in the spring of 2010. The Cyclones have won 4 consecutive league

championships and 56 of their last 59 games. The Cyclones hail from St Charles, Missouri, a St Louis suburb.

Cyclone Head Coach Troy Robertson heads a superb Cyclone coaching staff, but you don't build a Cyclone-like record without highly talented players--- and the Cyclones have a lot of them. 6'6" longtime Cyclone QB Mike McMullen (Glendale CC) has become one of the country's most celebrated adult amateur QBs on an annual basis after a 9-year career as a BASEBALL pitcher in the San Francisco Giants' organization. And he has lots of help from players like former All-Big 12 RB Zac Abron (Missouri), Safety/Kick Returner Marqueas McLaurin (Iowa), and Defensive Tackles Arjay Ratliff (Michigan) and Elton Brown (Illinois). Former TSU WR Shannon Lightfoot adds a little "Nashville flavor" to the Cyclones. All in all, the Cyclones will be a formidable challenge for the Storm.

THE STAKES- This is an important early-season game for both teams. The Nashville Storm go into the game with a lifetime record of 99-17, and are seeking their 100th lifetime victory----- since the Storm's next game (on July 10) is on the road, the Storm would like to get win #100 in front of the home folks. For the Cyclones (undefeated in AFL play), this game counts as an AFL LEAGUE GAME, so they will be highly motivated to keep their AFL record unblemished for future playoff seeding. Also, since both teams are regarded as "National Top 20" teams by the 4 national ranking services, the outcome of this game will have a significant impact on the national rankings of all 4 services.

THE ENTERTAINMENT- The lovely ladies of the 18-member Nashville Storm Dance team will perform and lead the cheers, while musical entertainment

will be provided by DJ Lil Les and the good folks from Nashville Storm sponsor radio station 102.5 The Party.
